



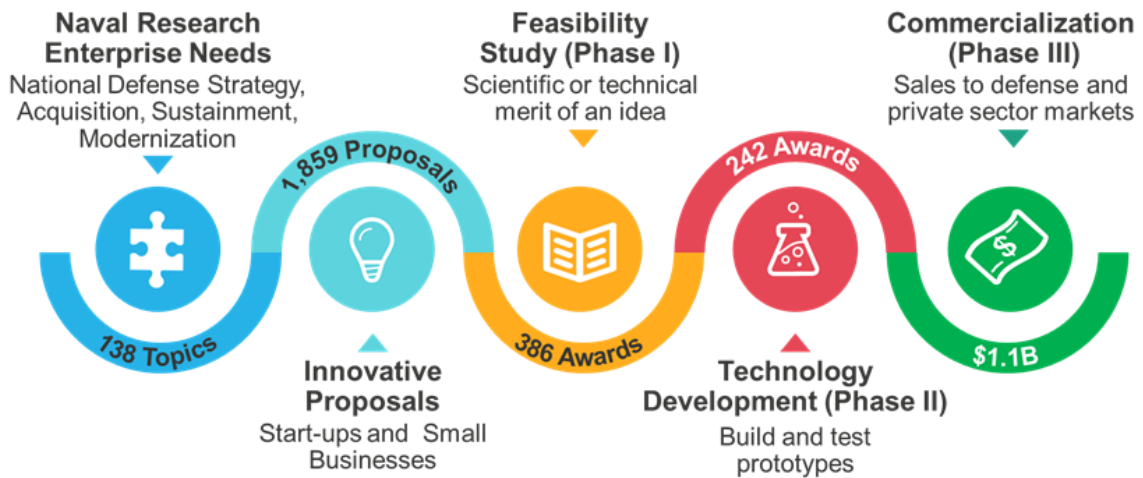
DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY SBIR/STTR PROGRAMS

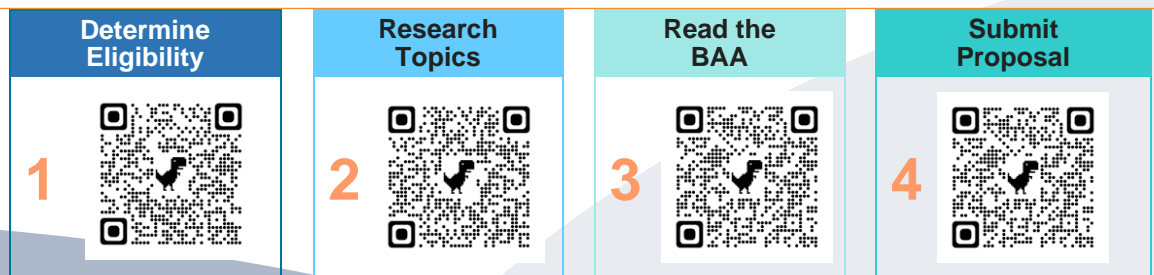

23.1/A BAA Schedule

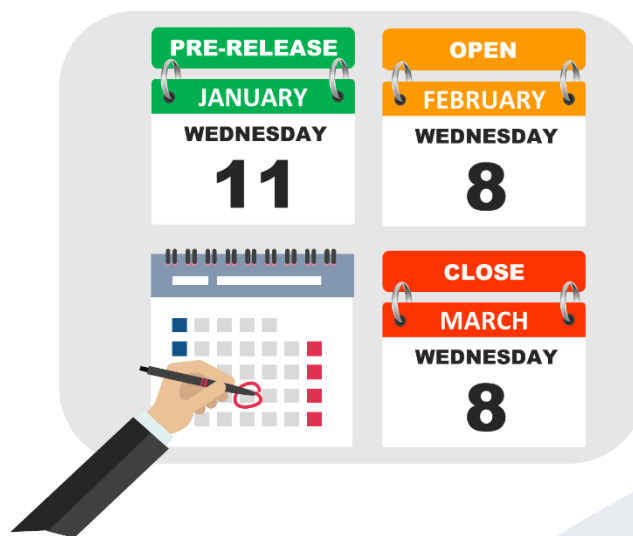
DON SBIR 23.1 and STTR 23.A topics are now open for proposal submissions. This funding opportunity includes 78 standard Navy SBIR Phase I topics, 6 SBIR Direct to Phase II topics, and 29 STTR topics from five of the Navy's Systems Commands. The DoD and DON SBIR 23.1/STTR 23.A BAAs will close for proposal submissions on March 8 at 12:00 PM ET.
