Focus: Capabilities vary, including disaster relief, maritime security operations, and sea control. Training is relevant and realistic, with exercises focusing on amphibious operations, gunnery, missiles, anti-submarine warfare, counter-piracy, mine clearance, explosive ordnance disposal, and diving/salvage operations.

Location: Honolulu, HI

Type of Event: Exercise

Entry Criteria: No prior FLEX experiment required. Review DoD Sponsorship, FIMS, cyber and install compliance, alignment to operational requirements and tasking. Consider application deadline and get involved early in the planning process to ensure the best possible support during the exercise.

Challenges: Length between entry deadline and execution, each initiative funds own costs, including travel. Installation, execution, and data collection and analysis plans must be scoped to minimize training impacts. Experiments must be integrated into the schedule of events (SOE).
